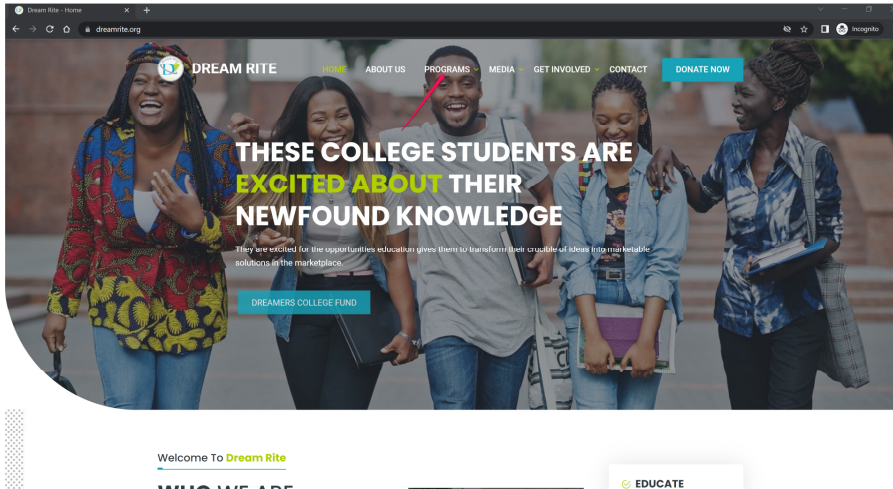
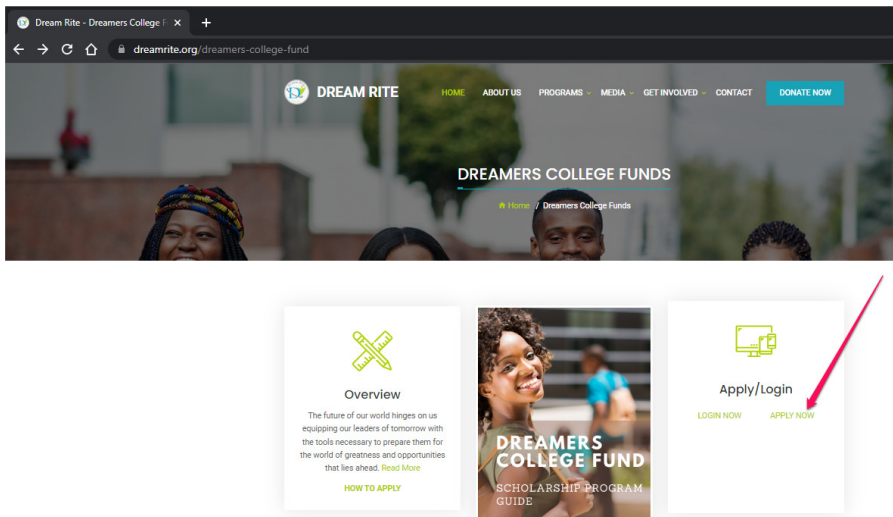


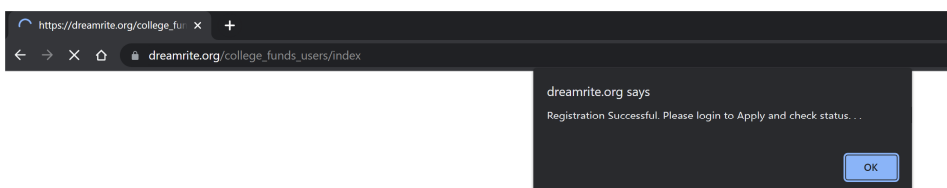
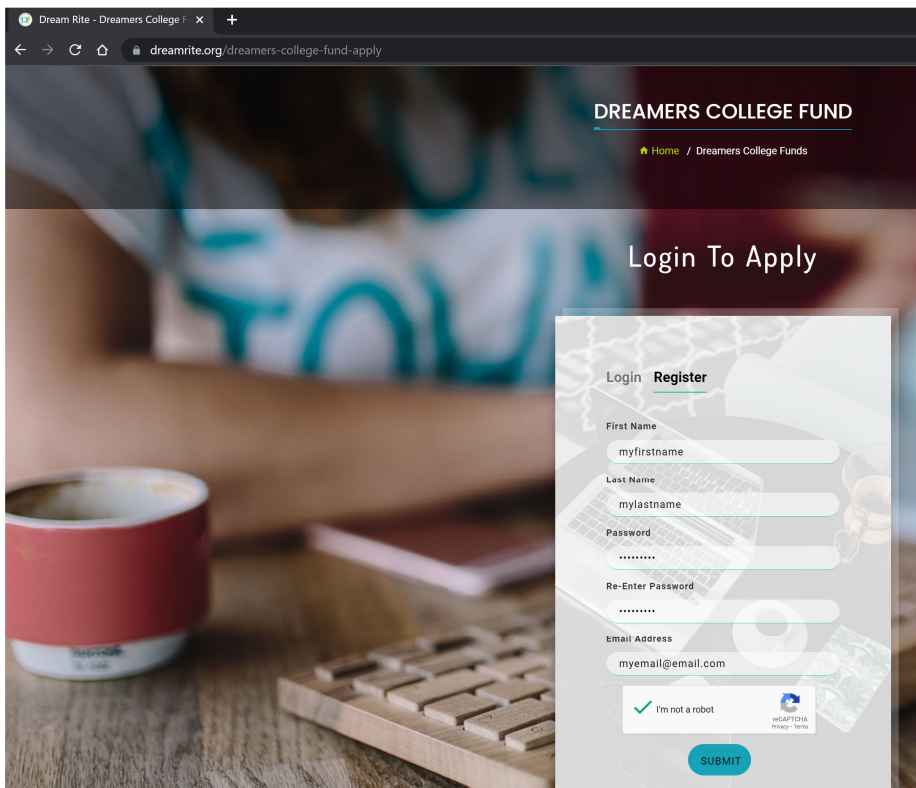
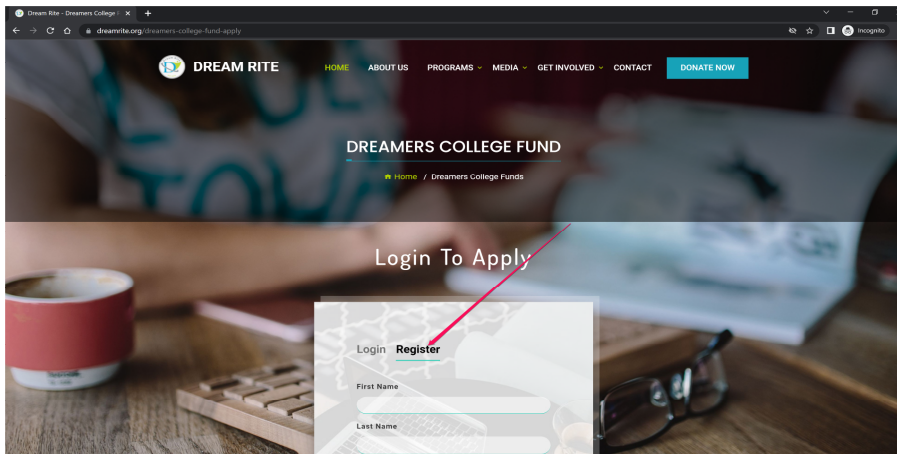
1. Go to **dreamrite.org**, click on **PROGRAMS** and select **DREAMERS COLLEGE FUND**



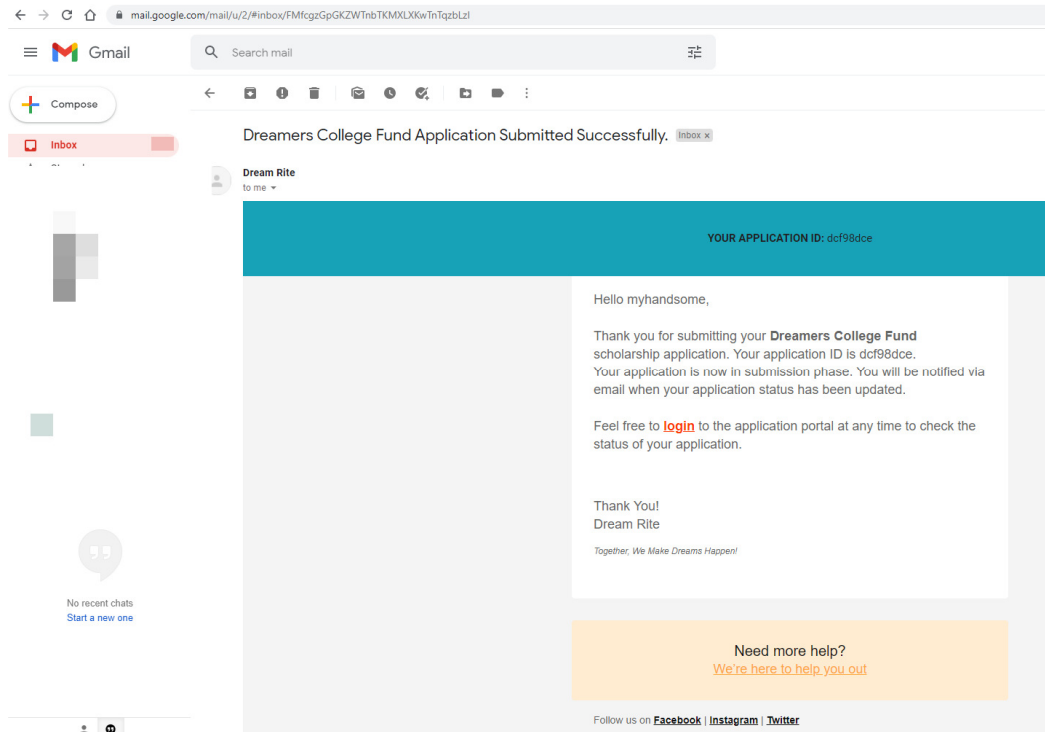
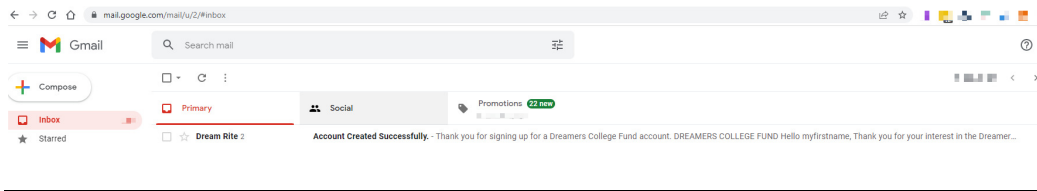
2. Click on **APPLY NOW**



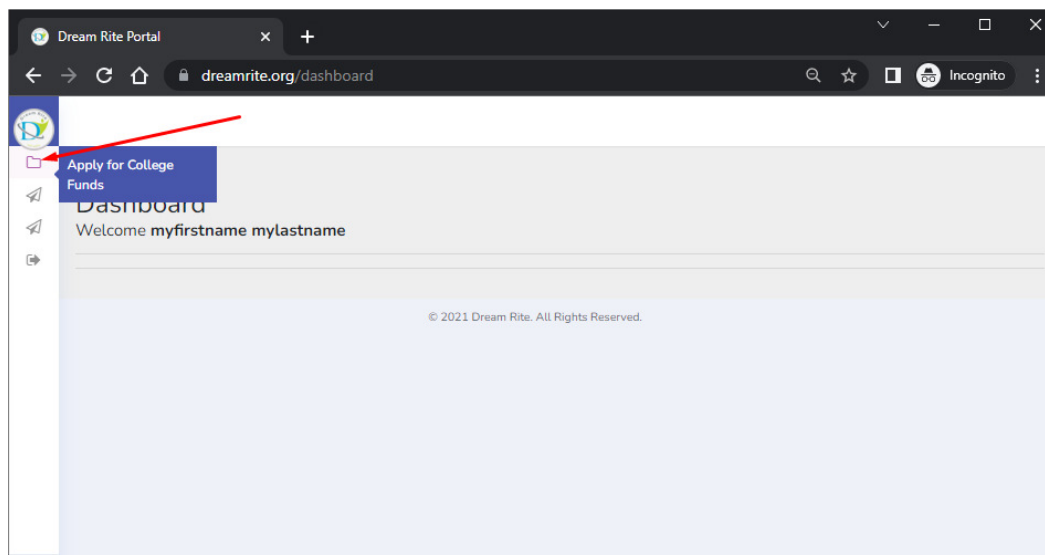
3. Click on **Register** tab and complete the required information and click **Submit**.



4. Check your email to see the account creation notification email from Dream Rite. Click on **login** link in the email to log into your account and begin the application process.

7. Note that you are required to write **two essays** as part of the application. The essays are to be entered on the last page of the application form before submitting the application. Each essay is to include a **minimum of 250 words response**. The essay questions are:
 - a. **Describe your vision of where you will be and what you would have achieved in the next 10 years**
 - b. **What do you hope to achieve from a college degree and how would you evaluate the success of your college education?**
