


1. Go to dreamrite.org, click on PROGRAMS and select DREAMERS COLLEGE FUND




2. Click on APPLY NOW




3. Click on **Register** tab and complete the required information and click **Submit**.









4. Check your email to see the account creation notification email from Dream Rite. Click on **login** link in the email to log into your account and begin the application process.

- 7. Note that you are required to write <u>two essays</u> as part of the application. The essays are to be entered on the last page of the application form before submitting the application. Each essay is to include a <u>minimum of 250 words response</u>. The essay questions are:
 - a. Describe your vision of where you will be and what you would have achieved in the next 10 years
 - b. What do you hope to achieve from a college degree and how would you evaluate the success of your college education?
